2017+ SILVERADO MOUNTING KIT FOR C3100 SPEAKER - SINGLE AND DUAL

Introduction:

This bracket kit fits 2017+ Silverado and mounts the Code3 C3100 speaker either singly or in pairs side by side.

For speaker specifications see the Code3 C3100 installation manual.

Installation and Mounting:




Figure 1 Single Speaker Version




Figure 2 Dual Speaker Version

Step 1. For a single speaker application, assemble the C3100 speaker to the mounting plate as shown in figure 1. For a dual speaker application, assemble the C3100 speaker to the mounting plate as shown in figure 2. Use (4) of the #12 phillips head screws and lock washers that are supplied in the #55025 hardware bags to mount each of the C3100 speakers. Make sure the "MOUNT WITH THIS END UP" "CAUTION!" label is on the top as oriented in the views in Figures 1 & 2 below. Discard the remaining hardware.

Step 2. Locate the vehicle's (2) 10mm bolts that hold the front end of the black plastic engine cover underneath the front of the Silverado (See Figure 3) and remove the bolts (See Figure 4).

Step 3. With the C3100 speaker assembly held so that the speakers are at the top and facing the front of the Silverado, pull the Silverado's black cover away from the frame cross member and slip the wide flange of the C3100 mounting plate in between the cross member and the cover. Align the holes in the C3100 mounting plate with the holes in the frame cross member and thread the 10 mm bolts that were removed in Step 2 through the holes in the black cover, through the mounting plate holes and into the holes in the silverado's frame cross member. Be very careful not to cross thread the bolts.

Step 3. Tighten the 10mm bolts to secure the assembly (See Figures 5 & 6 on page 3).

Step 4. Route the wiring as desired to connect to the siren.
